



Heartwood Raffle Rules

Heartwood Regional Theater Company, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, is conducting this raffle as a fund raiser. Raffle winners will be determined by random drawing and winners will be contacted via email or phone on August 7, 2022. Winners' names will be made public via email to Heartwood's database and all raffle participants.

Each winner will receive their prize, after providing Heartwood with a completed W-9 tax form; Heartwood will furnish a 1099-Misc form at year end, 2022.

The winner of the **Currarevagh House** package in Ireland will receive \$1,000 immediately and be connected to the owner via email to book a 5-night stay at a mutually agreed upon time, within a 3-year period, ending August 6th, 2025.

The winner of the **London** package will receive \$1,000 immediately and will be introduced (if winner wishes) via email to Joseph Cote, the London travel planner. At the time of hotel booking, within a 2-year period ending August 6th, 2024, Heartwood will pay the winner an additional \$1,000 to be used for rooming and/or other associated expenses. If the winner opts not to book / travel by August 6th, 2024, winner will forfeit the additional \$1,000 for lodging.

The winner of the **Airbnb** gift card must reside in the United States, according to Airbnb Gift Card Restrictions, and must have a valid form of payment for Airbnb charges. Heartwood will pay the winner \$250 immediately and will purchase the gift card from Airbnb, once a winner is chosen.

All winners must confirm their prize within thirty (30) days of the drawing, by responding via phone or email.

Tickets may be purchased online until 10pm on August 6th, 2022 (EST) or by mailing a completed registration form with payment to Heartwood, received by August 6th, 2022.

The purchase price for one raffle ticket is \$50 and is non-refundable.

When purchasing a ticket, entrants certify that they are **18 years or older**, by the date of the drawing, August 7th, 2022.

All purchased tickets will be maintained in Heartwood's possession for at least three (3) years.
